The Seekers was a group of young people that had its beginnings in the early 1970s. The group began with two or three young people under the direction of Pastor Robert Dismukes (late husband of our Shirley Dismukes and father of our David Dismukes), who was beginning his ministry as pastor of Providence. The group would meet weekly for Bible Study and prayer under Brother Robert. The growth was miraculous from just a few to more than 100 young people committing to the "seeking" of a closer relationship with the Lord. As a result, there were at least 18 men called to some kind of full-time ministry during that time period. Those who were "called" to preach as teenagers were called the Preacher Boys.
